WHAT IS THE WHOLESALE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT – NEW TERRITORY (WPCA-NT)?



The Levelized Purchased Power Factor (LPPF) charged to former Allegheny Power (AP) customers expired on June 30, 2011. Starting July 1, the LPPF was replaced by the State Corporation Commission (SCC) approved Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment – New Territory (WPCA-NT).

This charge is a pass-through of the variable costs of generating and acquiring wholesale power for REC members. Twice a year, the WPCA-NT is reviewed and adjusted – either up or down as appropriate.

The charge reflects actual costs only; it does not include a mark-up or profit margin.

To benefit REC members in the area formerly served by AP, the SCC required AP to contribute approximately \$13.75 million over four years to help reduce future electric bills. Starting July 1, this money will be returned in the form of a bill credit, referred to as a Transition Credit. For someone using 1000 kWh per month the credit will total \$5.85.
