### **EDUCATION:**

Associate Degree required in Electrical/Electronic Technology or Computer Science. Six (6) years directly related progressively responsible post high school experience and participation in the State of Virginia Apprenticeship Program may substitute for degree.

### **EXPERIENCE:**

Six years (6) experience working with SCADA and Load Management/AMR computers, personal computers, peripherals, programs, with emphasis on all related substation and downline field equipment. Six years (6) experience in telecommunications systems (fiber optic splicing, fusion splicing, testing, termination, fiber installation, telephone, microwave, WAN, LAN and two-way radio field) required.

### **JOB KNOWLEDGE:**

Must have a thorough knowledge of electronics and high voltage safety practices. Must have thorough operating knowledge of SCADA and Load Management/AMR Systems as installed (hardware and software). Must have thorough operating knowledge of all Cooperative telecommunications equipment as installed. Must have a working knowledge of electronics and electrical systems. Must have a thorough knowledge of electronic operated power equipment, reclosers, regulators, and transformers. Must possess basic computer skills, to include a working knowledge of Microsoft Office products, including, but not limited to: Outlook, Excel, Word and PowerPoint as required by job responsibilities.
