Understanding of system maps, staking sheets, and other work/maintenance order procedures required of this job desired. Knowledge of construction specifications and National Electric Safety Code requirements pertaining to line construction desired. Must keep informed of all Cooperative operating policies. ### ABILITIES & SKILLS:

Must have the ability and skill to carry out all apparatus installation, maintenance, and testing programs. Must be able to climb ladders to perform apparatus maintenance or installations. Must possess or obtain a valid Class A Commercial Driver's License (CDL) within the first six (6) months of employment. Must possess basic computer skills, to include a working knowledge of Microsoft Office products, including, but not limited to: Outlook, Excel, Word and PowerPoint as required by job responsibilities. Perform other duties as assigned.

### WORKING CONDITIONS:

Must travel to various substations and locations throughout the system to complete many work assignments. The balance will be performed within the Fredericksburg Maintenance Facility or Apparatus shop. Must be willing and able to work in all weather conditions. Occasional overtime may be required. Work in all weather conditions for outage restoration. Must be able to perform hard physical labor when necessary including lifting and carrying up to 75 pounds. Wearing Personal Protective Equipment such as safety-toed shoes/boots, safety glasses, flame-retardant clothing, rubber gloves and sleeves is required. Occasional travel away from the cooperative service territory may be required for training.
