

**RAPPAHANNOCK ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE
AGGREGATED AGRICULTURAL NET METERING FORM**

The Cooperative is required to notify the State Corporation Commission of all registered net metering accounts. Pursuant to Virginia Administrative Code Section 20 VAC 5-315-20 and §56-594.B of the Code of Virginia, the customer may aggregate for billing purposes the meter that is physically attached to the net metering generator(s) with one or more additional meters. The following conditions must exist to aggregate service.

1. The aggregated meters are located on land owned or controlled by the agricultural business
2. Customer may be served by multiple meters of one utility that are located at separate but contiguous sites
3. The agricultural business is engaged primarily in the production and sale of plants and animals, products collected from plants and animals, or plants and animal services that are useful to the public
