ELECTRIFYING AMERICA'S RURAL SCHOOL BUSES

DON'T MISS YOUR CHANCE TO GET A **FREE** **ELECTRIC SCHOOL BUS**

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is now accepting applications from eligible organizations for a \$500 million rebate program covering the purchase of electric school buses and related charging infrastructure. The application process is relatively simple and the first round applications are due by August 19, 2022.



PRIORITY SCHOOLS

The program gives priority to schools serving high percentages of children living below the poverty line, to high-need schools and schools in both rural and low-income areas. Priority schools are eligible to receive \$395,000 per bus.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?



STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS/SCHOOLS

Entities responsible for providing school bus service or purchasing buses



ELIGIBLE CONTRACTORS

For-profit, not-for-/non-profit entities that have the capacity to sell electric school buses or other equipment needed to charge, fuel, or maintain electric school buses to school bus operators
